

The Four Rules of Basic Gun Safety



1. Treat every firearm as if were loaded, at all times.
2. Always keep your finger off the trigger (on the frame) until your sights are on the target and you have made the decision to fire.
3. **NEVER** point the gun at anything you are not willing to destroy.
4. Always be certain of your target, what is behind it and beyond it.
